About the District . . .

The Beverly Hills Unified School District consists of four K-8 elementary schools, one 9-12 high school and an adult school. The K-12 enrollment is approximately 5,175. Adult School enrollment is approximately 5,098

The district employs approximately 320 certificated and 150 classified personnel. The staff is dedicated and highly capable. The teachers' salary schedule is one of the highest among K-12 districts in California.

The district is recognized nationally as a leader in education. Students have consistently scored far above national averages on standardized achievement tests, and 94% go on to colleges and universities.

Each elementary school consists of a primary school (K-2), an intermediate school (3-5), and a middle school (6-8). Beverly Hills High School is organized around three houses, each one headed by an assistant principal who is assisted by two counselors. While academic subjects are stressed in the elementary schools and the high school, a broad and comprehensive educational program is offered. Average class size is 27 students.

About the Community . . .

The Beverly Hills Unified School District serves approximately 34,000 community members. Community support for education has been a long-standing tradition in Beverly Hills. Many residents have been attracted to Beverly Hills because of their high regard for the school district's educational program. Parents are highly supportive and help to insure an outstanding educational program for their children through their volunteerism and financial support.
