Overnight Trips: Unit members shall be paid \$250 per night of duty for all overnight trips.

- STEP 1 Day-to-day Substitute Teachers
- STEP 2Long-Term Substitute Teachers (After reaching 10 5 consecutive working days in

assignment.) This position may require lesson planning and preparation.
- STEP 3 Extended-Term Substitute Teachers (After reaching 10 consecutive working days in same assignment, or on day 1 of a planned absence of more than 10 working days.) This position shall require lesson planning and preparation, grading, attending staff meetings and professional development, and communicating with families (conferencing if necessary).

The committee for Extra Pay for Coaching Athletic Teams (see Section 4 of Salaries) shall review the current coaching stipends and make recommendations for the bargaining team. The Association members of the committee shall receive release time to attend committee meetings or shall be paid the certificated hourly rate for attendance at meetings occurring outside regular duty time.

ARTICLE IV HOURS

Section 1 HOURS REQUIRED ON SITE TA 12/6/2023

4. Each unit member shall be assigned preparation time as follows: teachers in grades TK-5 and specialists shall be provided at least 250 minutes of uninterrupted preparation time per week distributed in increments of at least 20 minutes in length, including time within the 7.5 workday after student dismissal. Teachers in grades 6-8 shall be provided at least 250 minutes of uninterrupted preparation time per week distributed in full period increments. Teachers in grades 9-12 shall be provided at least 260 minutes of uninterrupted preparation time per week distributed in full period increments. Teachers in grades 9-12 shall be provided at least 260 minutes of uninterrupted preparation time per week distributed in full period increments. All other unit members shall be provided at least 250 minutes of uninterrupted preparation time per week. Every effort shall be made to maximize the length of uninterrupted preparation time increments. In cases of emergency or special programs, every effort shall be made to equalize preparation time among unit members at the work site during the school year. Section 2

Section 2 PROFESSIONAL DUTIES, LUNCH PERIODS AND OTHER HOURS OF ASSIGNMENT TA 12/6/2023

Each employee is responsible for classroom duties (or, in the case of non-classroom teachers, scheduled duties) for which he or she is properly credentialed, and for all related and reasonable professional duties. Such professional duties include the following examples: instructional planning preparing lesson plans; preparing and selecting instructional materials; reviewing and evaluating the work of pupils; communicating and conferring with pupils, parents, staff and

administrators; maintaining appropriate records, including assigning and entering at least one graded assignment at 6-12 only, on average every other week using one of the current electronic grading programs, providing leadership and supervision of student activities; providing direction for instructional assistants when assigned; cooperating in parent, community, and open house activities; general supervision of pupils both within and outside the classroom; participating in staff development programs, professional activities related to unit member's assignment, independent study and otherwise keeping current with developments within areas of subjects of assignment; assuming reasonable responsibility for the proper use and control of District property, equipment, material and supplies; and, at 6-12 only, daily campus supervision, on-campus club activities and other teacher assignments mutually agreed to by the unit members and the principal. Teachers may be assigned to yard duty supervision only when they have voluntarily accepted such assignments and been approved to be paid for such assignments at the certificated hourly rate, and no rotating yard duty supervision shall be otherwise required of teachers except in cases of emergency. Time shall be accounted for in 15-minute increments, and any fraction of a 15-minute increment worked shall be paid for the full 15-minute increment. Except for emergency situations, bargaining unit members shall be provided at least a 40- minute duty free lunch period within the hours of 11: 10 a.m. and 1:50 p.m.

Section 3 STAFF MEETINGS TA 1/18/2023

All Wednesday morning meetings shall be at the discretion of the site principal with the following exception: 5 Wednesday mornings shall be reserved for self-directed Personal Professional Days following the guidelines set below:

- Must be in attendance in person at the regular start of your school day
- At the start of the school year, teachers will identify what they are working on for the school year (shall be aligned with school goals and/or the BHUSD strategic plan goals)

Agenda and feedback forms from PPD shall be submitted, at the request of site administrators, within 48 hours of the PPD to supervising administrator in charge of your department/grade level.

Section 5 School Calendar **TA 11/1/2023** Calendar Committee

The calendar committee shall meet and propose calendars for the bargaining team to negotiate. The Association members of the committee shall receive release time to attend committee meetings or shall be paid the certificated hourly rate for attendance at meetings occurring outside regular duty time. Section 1 TA 12/19/2023

Unit members hired prior to July 1, 1997, shall be eligible to purchase voluntary insurances, including cancer insurance, life insurance (up to \$50,000), income protection insurance, or other mutually agreed upon plans made available to the district.

ARTICLE 21 TERM OF AGREEMENT TA 3/18/2024

This Agreement shall be in full force and effect from July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2027, with reopeners in the second and third years limited to compensation, health, welfare and other benefits, two other articles of the Association's choice and two other articles of the District's choice for each of the reopened years. Additional articles may be opened by mutual agreement between the parties. However, the deliberations of the three subcommittees created during the 2020-2021 negotiations school year (1 Contract Cleanup, 2 Extra Pay and 3 Evaluation) may cause the related articles within the jurisdiction of the subcommittees to be reopened for the express purpose of incorporating into such articles any agreements resulting from the recommendations of the subcommittees implementing any resulting agreements.
