1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

BHUSD staffed 3.2 FTE, providing direct instruction in vocal music, drama, and theater arts. Honor Choir: Offers advanced training and performance opportunities for talented vocalists. OAKE (Organization of American Kodály Educators): Focuses on music education based on the Kodály method, emphasizing musical literacy through singing. Art Show: Provides a platform for students to showcase their artistic creations, fostering community involvement and artistic expression. Sheet Music: Provides access to a diverse repertoire of music, essential for learning and performing various pieces, broadening musical experience. Art Supplies: Ensures students have necessary materials for creative exploration, including paints, brushes, canvases, and clay, supporting artistic expression and skill development. Butterfly Project Supplies and Services: Combines art with history and social justice education. Students create ceramic butterflies to commemorate the 1.5 million children who perished in the Holocaust, promoting empathy and understanding. Instrument Repair and Purchases: Ensures musical instruments are in good condition and accessible, supporting music programs across all grade levels.
