PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

In 2008, the City of Beverly Hills passed **Measure E**, authorizing \$334 million in bonds to make seismic safety repairs, upgrade aging school buildings, and better protect students and staff from security risks and natural disasters.

In 2018, the City of Beverly Hills passed **Measure BH**, authorizing \$385 million in bonds to upgrade and replace inefficient heating, cooling and electrical systems, fix deteriorating restroom facilities and leaky roofs, and provide modern classroom science and technology equipment. Developer fees are also utilized for certain construction items, in addition to the Bond funds.

PROGRESS OF THE MONTH SNAPSHOT

During the month of June, the following activities took place or were in progress:

Program Budget

- Reviewed encumbrances to determine which costs need to be carried over for the new fiscal year.
- Reviewed El Rodeo budget to see what encumbrances can be recouped.
- Took inventory of all Swinerton invoices to ensure billing is consistent with progress.

Committee/Board Meetings

- Prepared Board documents for approval of painting of BHHS lobby connecting A & B buildings, ahead of 2025-2026 school year.
- Prepared Board documents for approval of new flooring for BHHS lobby connecting A & B buildings, ahead of 2025-2026 school year.

Bids/Requests for Proposal

- Requested Proposals for second phase of air monitoring services. Three proposals received and under review. Recommendation for award expected 7/22/25 board meeting.
- Requested Proposals for Materials Testing and Special Inspection for the BHHS Grand Lawn Project. Proposals due by 7/3/25. Recommendation for award expected 7/22/25 board meeting.

Progress at Sites

- BHHS B3/B4: B3 Finishes in full swing through Auditorium. Rigging equipment and AV wiring installation in process throughout Stage area. B4 Finishes in full swing throughout B4. Cabinet and flooring installation underway. Preparations for Salter's seating install underway.
- BHHS Grand Lawn: West Courtyard work scheduled to begin August 1, Grand Lawn by mid-August. District arborist completed evaluation.
- BHHS Upper Athletic Fields: Fencing installation around tennis court and prep for install around softball field underway. Soil nailing for RW#2 complete. Rebar for final concrete face starts early July.
- BHHS Building C: Extensive earthwork, underground utility installations, concrete work underway. Investigation in process for upcoming excavation work.
- South Site-Athletic Fields & Parking Lot: Preparing for future development.

FONDER-SALARI TEAM ACTIVITES OF THE MONTH

During the month of June, the Fonder-Salari, Inc. (FSI) team managed the bid opening for the re-painting and replacement of flooring for the BHHS lobby connecting the B Building to the Bridge. This will update the lobby to match the renovated B3 Building once B3 is opened to students for the upcoming school year.

FSI reviewed the remaining EI Rodeo budget, to see which encumbrances will no longer be needed and may be returned to the General Budget. In total, a savings of over \$5million has been realized over the budget set for EI Rodeo when FSI arrived at Beverly Hills USD.

FSI reviewed all Swinerton invoices to ensure that billing matched the amount of work completed, and to track all retention amounts deducted from the billing.

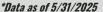

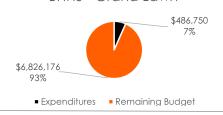
PER PROJECT* EXPENDITURE VS. REMAINING BUDGET—









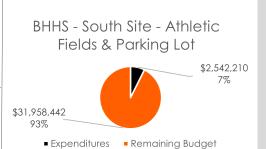


BHHS - Upper Athletic Fields

PROGRAM RISKS

- Availability of funds: Based on the recent project estimates, available funds are insufficient to cover all future projects.
- Future projects timeline: FSI Team is exploring options to optimize the priority, start, phasing, and duration for future projects, to minimize the impact of the cost escalations.
- Reconfiguration and Value Engineering of Future Projects: Design and approval duration may cause additional duration, potential escalation for overall program.
- DTSC approval: Receiving approval from DTSC for Upper Athletic Field and Building C may impact timelines for future projects.

- Identify most time and budget-efficient means of demolishing existing Konheim building.

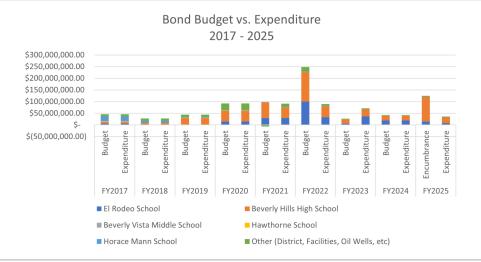

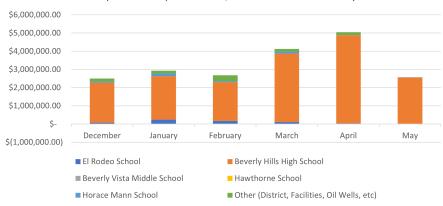

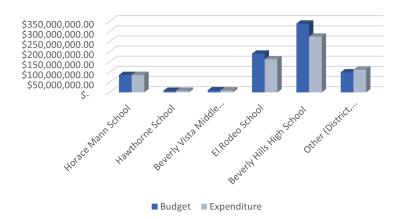
BOND BUDGET STATUS UPDATE *Data as of 5/31/2025



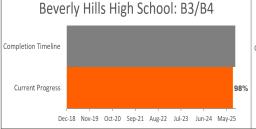
Bond Expenditure per Month, December 2024 - May 2025

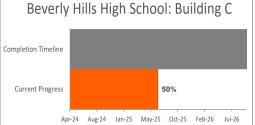


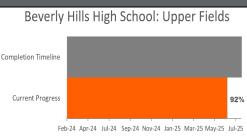
Total Bond Fund Expenditure per Project
