PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

In 2008, the City of Beverly Hills passed **Measure E**, authorizing \$334 million in bonds to make seismic safety repairs, upgrade aging school buildings, and better protect students and staff from security risks and natural disasters.

In 2018, the City of Beverly Hills passed **Measure BH**, authorizing \$385 million in bonds to upgrade and replace inefficient heating, cooling and electrical systems, fix deteriorating restroom facilities and leaky roofs, and provide modern classroom science and technology equipment. Developer fees are also utilized for certain construction items, in addition to the Bond funds.

PROGRESS OF THE MONTH SNAPSHOT

During the month of July, the following activities took place or were in progress:

<u>Program Budget</u>

- Reviewed contracts for B3/B4 inspection to ensure all costs are covered through the end of the project.
- Updated team staffing plan and organizational chart to reflect staffing anticipated for the coming fiscal year.
- Finalized list of purchase orders to be carried over into Fiscal Year 2026.

Committee/Board Meetings

- Prepared Board documents for approval of Amendment #4 to Swinerton contract, including restoration of Building B3 west courtyard.
- Prepared Board documents for approval of contract extending DSA Inspection services with Pringle Group.

Bids/Requests for Proposal

- Requested Proposals for Materials Testing and Special Inspection for the BHHS Grand Lawn Project. Selection made and recommendation for award expected at 8/26/25 board meeting.
- Preparation began for the RFQ/P process for a Design-Build entity for the South Site Parking Lot Project.

Progress at Sites

- BHHS B3/B4: B3 Finish work continues. B4 Finish work underway to allow students to occupy B4 Building when school starts in August.
- BHHS Grand Lawn: Completed and submitted the arborist report for the five trees along Moreo Drive. Project set to begin September 2.
- BHHS Upper Athletic Fields: Tennis courts play surface complete. Base installation underway for softball field, with turf installation scheduled for early August. Retaining Wall #2 concrete work complete. Formwork for plaza area and rebar installation for seating underway.
 BHHS Building C: Footing and rebar installation underway. Initial cast-in-place wall setup.
- BHHS Building C: Footing and rebar installation underway. Initial cast-in-place wall setup CMU block work underway in Gym lobby. West Courtyard demo completed. Prep for underground electrical and lighting in progress.
- South Site-Athletic Fields & Parking Lot: Preparing for future development.

FONDER-SALARI TEAM ACTIVITES OF THE MONTH

During the month of July, the Fonder-Salari, Inc. (FSI) team received approval from the Department of Toxic Substance Control (DTSC) for the BHHS—Building C and BHHS—South Site—Athletic Fields and Parking Lot projects. Approval of the remedial action plan for these projects removes a major risk for delay.

FSI prepared documents for the approval of Amendment No. 4 to the contract with Swinerton, so that they will cover the restoration of the courtyard west of Building B3. This area was not included in the contract made with ProWest prior to FSI's arrival at BHUSD.

FSI reviewed all purchase orders with funds remaining from the previous fiscal year to see which needed to be carried over into Fiscal Year 2026. This ensured that necessary contracts would have no disruption in available funds.

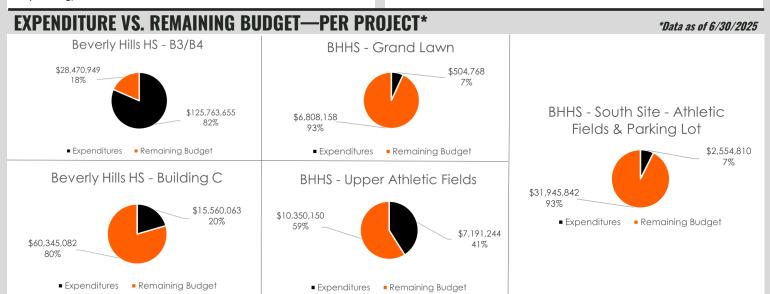

- Reconfiguration and Value Engineering of Future Projects: Design and approval duration may cause additional duration, potential escalation for overall program.

- Identify most time and budget-efficient means of demolishing existing Konheim building.

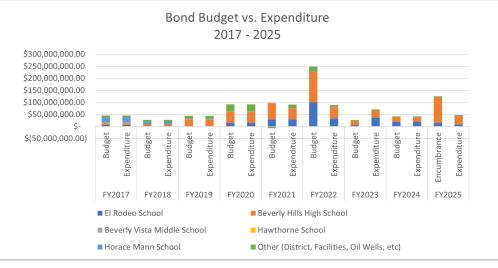

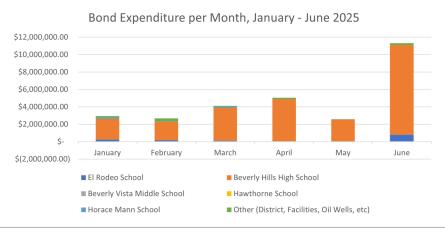

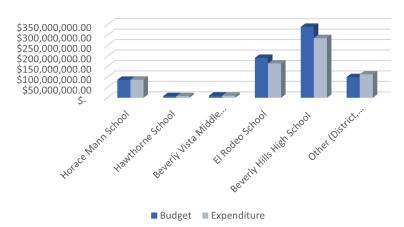

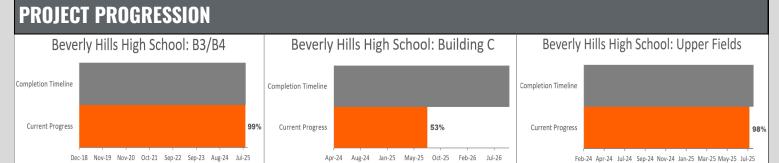
BOND BUDGET STATUS UPDATE *Data as of 6/30/2025
