PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

In 2008, the City of Beverly Hills passed Measure E, authorizing \$334 million in bonds to make seismic safety repairs, upgrade aging school buildings, and better protect students and staff from security risks and natural disasters.

In 2018, the City of Beverly Hills passed Measure BH, authorizing \$385 million in bonds to upgrade and replace inefficient heating, cooling and electrical systems, fix deteriorating restroom facilities and leaky roofs, and provide modern classroom science and technology equipment. Developer fees are also utilized for certain construction items, in addition to the Bond funds.

PROGRESS OF THE MONTH SNAPSHOT

During the month of February, the following activities took place or were in progress:

- Board approved Acceptance of Completion for projects at El Rodeo ES and Horace Mann ES.
 Last funds in Measure E allocated to bills for El Rodeo ES. No Measure E funds remain.
- Fonder-Salari and District financial departments met to review 2nd quarter Bond budget.

- Board approved El Rodeo ES project to repair Ball Wall.
- Prepared Board documents for additional specialty inspection necessary to finish B3/B4
- Board approved Horace Mann ES Shade Structure projects for Existing Playground & TK Patio.

Preparation for BHHS B3/B4 FF&E Contracts.

Progress at Sites

- El Rodeo: Completed.
- BHHS B3/B4: B3: Balcony step framing has started. Work continues in the Stage Basement with metal stud framing and drywall installation. **B4:** Metal stud framing and drywall installation is nearly complete on 1st floor. Framing and rough-in work has started on 2nd floor, east side.
- BHHŚ Grand Lawn: GMP review is ongoing.
- BHHS Upper Athletic Fields: Completed construction of underground concrete piles along Retaining Wall #2. Contractor continues to grade upper field. Site mobilization complete.
- BHHS Building C: Earthwork has started with removing and transferring of soils. Soil nail placement, drilling and grouting for Retaining Walls #3 & #4 have begun.

 South Site-Athletic Fields & Parking Lot: Backfill complete. Preparing for future development.
- SwimGym Boiler Project: Punch list items are being addressed.

Developer Fees:

Horace Mann: Shades structures installed. ADA boys' restroom upgrades will be completed during Spring Break. Installation of new ornamental fencing gate will be done over Spring

FONDER-SALARI TEAM ACTIVITES OF THE MONTH

During the month of February, the Fonder-Salari, Inc. (FSI) team obtained the Acceptance of Completion for the Ball Wall repair at El Rodeo Elementary School as well as two Shade Structure projects at Horace Mann Elementary School.

FSI initiated the allocation of all remaining Measure E funds to the ProWest Constructors contract at El Rodeo ES, ensuring that Measure E funds are completely used up on appropriate projects.

FSI met with the District's Executive Director - Construction Services, Director of Fiscal Services, Administrative Assistant II and Financial Analyst to review the Bond Construction budget for the second quarter of the fiscal year. FSI advised on minor changes that were needed to keep the budget on track for the remainder of the fiscal year.

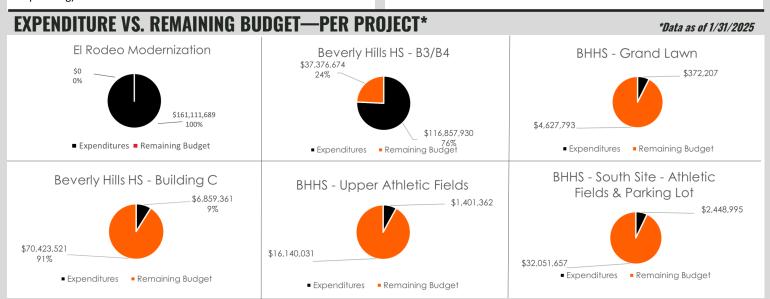

PROGRAM RISKS

- Availability of funds: Based on the recent project estimates, available funds are insufficient to cover all future projects.
- Future projects timeline: FSI Team is exploring options to optimize the priority, start, phasing, and duration for future projects, to minimize the impact of the cost escalations.
- Reconfiguration and Value Engineering of Future Projects: Design and approval duration may cause additional duration, potential escalation for overall program.
- **DTSC approval**: Receiving approval from DTSC for Upper Athletic Field and Building C may impact timelines for future projects.

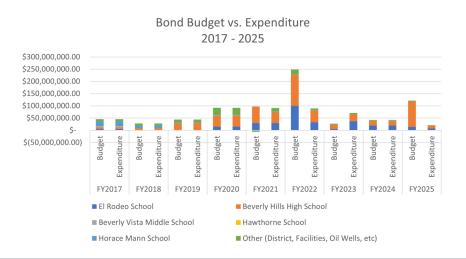

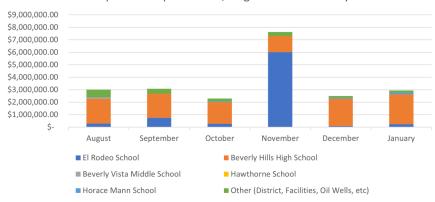

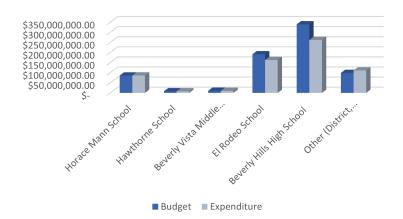
BOND BUDGET STATUS UPDATE *Data as of 1/31/2025



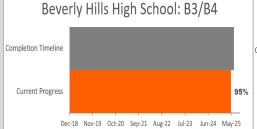
Bond Expenditure per Month, August 2024 - January 2025

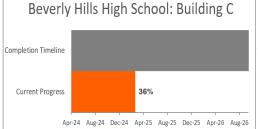


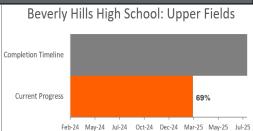
Total Bond Fund Expenditure per Project
