### PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

In 2008, the City of Beverly Hills passed Measure E, authorizing \$334 million in bonds to make seismic safety repairs, upgrade aging school buildings, and better protect students and staff from security risks and natural disasters.

In 2018, the City of Beverly Hills passed Measure BH, authorizing \$385 million in bonds to upgrade and replace inefficient heating, cooling and electrical systems, fix deteriorating restroom facilities and leaky roofs, and provide modern classroom science and technology equipment. Developer fees are also utilized for certain construction items, in addition to the Bond funds.

## PROGRESS OF THE MONTH SNAPSHOT

During the month of March, the following activities took place or were in progress:

#### **Program Budget**

- Examined accounts for El Rodeo to ensure that invoices are paid and to see what funds may be recouped.
- Reviewed construction invoices to ensure retention is held per contract.
- Reviewed invoice from air monitoring and specialty inspection firms to ensure that all necessary backup is included, per audit recommendations.

#### Committee/Board Meetings

- Prepared Board documents for extension of general liability insurance needed to finish B3/B4
- Prepared Board documents for approval of design for value engineering items suggested by the Lease-Leaseback entity to be incorporated into the Building C plans.

#### Bids/Requests for Proposal

- Preparation for BHHS B3/B4 FF&E Contracts. To be presented to board at 4/15/2025 meeting.
- AV Equipment procurement for BHHS B3/B4 underway. Items will be contractor installed. To be presented to board at 4/15/2025 meeting.

#### **Progress at Sites**

- BHHS B3/B4: B3: Prepping for vinyl veneer on curved clouds nearing completion. Stage Basement starting to receive primer & paint. **B4:** 1st floor finishes underway. 2nd floor of East Side nearly framed out, drywall installation almost complete, tape/mud application underway.
- BHHS Grand Lawn: GMP review is ongoing.
  BHHS Upper Athletic Fields: Grading 70% complete. Retaining Wall #2 grading in process.
  BHHS Building C: Earthwork moves to night shifts following second vertical cut to meet
- regulations & minimize disruption. Second cut finished, third in progress. Soil nail installation continues, to support retaining walls.
- South Site-Athletic Fields & Parking Lot: Backfill complete. Preparing for future development.
- SwimGym Boiler Project: Punch list items are being addressed.

#### **Developer Fees:**

• Horace Mann: ADA boy's Restroom & Ornamental fence gate fence gate completed. Final walk found one remaining punch list item per project, contractors will address next week.

## FONDER-SALARI TEAM ACTIVITES OF THE MONTH

During the month of March, the Fonder-Salari, Inc. (FSI) team examined the contracts for the El Rodeo project to ensure that billing is up to date and to see what funds may be recouped from the project.

FSI reviewed construction invoices to ensure that retention is being deducted correctly from each invoice, in accordance with the contracts involved.

FSI reviewed inspection and air monitoring invoices, to ensure the correct backup and documentation was submitted with each. FSI discussed with vendors the need to submit appropriate backup to meet audit standards.

FSI is currently working on updating the overall program master schedule and master budget considering the latest developments related to the future projects.

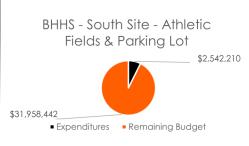

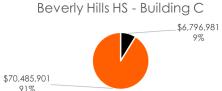
# **EXPENDITURE VS. REMAINING BUDGET—PER PROJECT\***

### **PROGRAM RISKS**

- Availability of funds: Based on the recent project estimates, available funds are insufficient to cover all future projects.
- Future projects timeline: FSI Team is exploring options to optimize the priority, start, phasing, and duration for future projects, to minimize the impact of the cost escalations.
- Reconfiguration and Value Engineering of Future Projects: Design and approval duration may cause additional duration, potential escalation for overall program.
- **DTSC approval**: Receiving approval from DTSC for Upper Athletic Field and Building C may impact timelines for future projects.

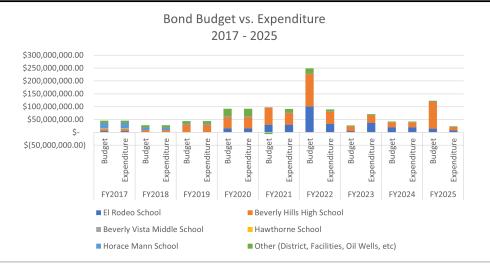

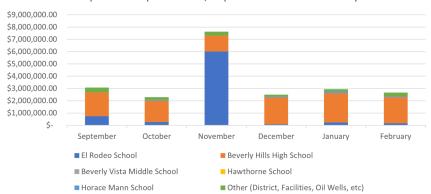

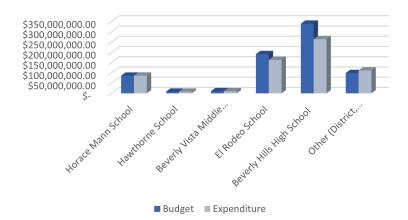
# BOND BUDGET STATUS UPDATE \*Data as of 2/28/2025



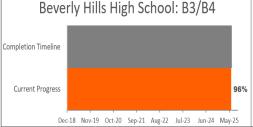
#### Bond Expenditure per Month, September 2024 - February 2025

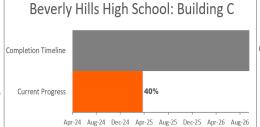


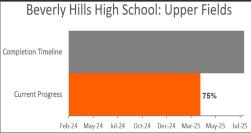
### Total Bond Fund Expenditure per Project
