



1	<b>Employee Information.</b> Displays your employee name and ID. This is used to identify you in the HCM System.
2	<b>Tax Info.</b> Displays Income tax withholding information, your allowances, marital status and exempt status when applicable.
3	<b>Hours &amp; Earnings.</b> Displays all types of earnings that count as income, such as regular pay/hours, shift differentials, overtime, incentives, etc.
4	<b>Rate.</b> Displays your hourly rate depending on how you are paid.
5	<b>Hours.</b> Displays the number of hours you worked.
6	<b>Employer Paid Benefits.</b> Displays Benefits and total amounts paid for by your employer
7	<p><b>Before Tax Deductions.</b> Displays the deductions/reductions taken from your earnings before taxes are calculated and withheld. These IRS defined items include pre-tax deductions such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Medical, dental, and vision premiums</li> <li>▪ Flexible Spending Accounts (Health &amp; Dependent Care Plans)</li> <li>▪ Deferred Compensation/Tax Sheltered Annuities</li> <li>▪ The Earned Salary Advance (ESA) reduction</li> <li>▪ CalPERS/CalSTRS Employee contributions</li> </ul>
8	<p><b>Taxes.</b> Displays statutory taxes taken after income taxes are calculated and withheld may include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Social Security (OASDI) tax</li> <li>▪ Medicare (MEDICARE) tax</li> <li>▪ Federal Withheld tax (FW State Withheld tax (SWT)</li> </ul>
9	<p><b>After-Tax Deductions.</b> Displays additional or voluntary deductions taken after taxes which may include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Credit Union Deductions</li> <li>▪ Supplemental Life Insurance</li> <li>▪ Union and/or Association Dues</li> <li>▪ State Disability Insurance Premium (SDI), if applicable</li> <li>▪ Medical, dental, and vision premiums</li> <li>▪ Flexible Spending Accounts (Health &amp; Dependent Care Plans)</li> </ul>
10	<b>Leave Balances.</b> Reflects sick and vacation balances based on your eligibility for the leave type.
11	<b>Subject Gross YTD.</b> Displays taxable gross dollar amount which forms the basis to calculate taxes.
12	<b>Direct Deposit.</b> Can be distributed to multiple accounts.
13	<b>Net Pay.</b> Reflects the total net amount of your paycheck.
