PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

In 2008, the City of Beverly Hills passed **Measure E**, authorizing \$334 million in bonds to make seismic safety repairs, upgrade aging school buildings, and better protect students and staff from security risks and natural disasters.

In 2018, the City of Beverly Hills passed **Measure BH**, authorizing \$385 million in bonds to upgrade and replace inefficient heating, cooling and electrical systems, fix deteriorating restroom facilities and leaky roofs, and provide modern classroom science and technology equipment. Developer fees are also utilized for certain construction items, in addition to the Bond funds.

PROGRESS OF THE MONTH SNAPSHOT

During the month of September, the following activities took place or were in progress:

Program Budget

- Prepared Bond budget summary for presentation to Board on program progress.
- Vetted pay applications for construction, supplying templates to contractors to list contingency billing.
- Analyzed invoicing requests to ensure that payments are only for items that fulfill Bond language requirements.

Committee/Board Meetings

- Prepared Board document for Notice of Completion of specific furniture & equipment contracts for the BHHS-B3/B4 Buildings project.
- Prepared and presented update on Construction Program process to the Board.

Bids/Requests for Proposal

 Preparation of the RFQ/P process to select a Design-Build entity for the South Site Parking Lot Project is on-going.

Progress at Sites

- BHHS B3/B4: B3 Seats installed. Finish work continues throughout Auditorium. B4 Punch work continues through the building.
- BHHS Grand Lawn: Demolition began. Soil with elevated lead levels was found on the site during routine testing, additional steps were required for safe removal. Excavation continued after removal.
- BHHS Upper Athletic Fields: Cameras, wireless access points, PA system installed for Softball Field and Tennis Courts. Lighting control and batting cages done for Softball Field. Upper Plaza handrails installed, Sections 1-2-3 seating/stairs poured, electrical & underground plumbing completed. Concrete sidewalks poured. Modular Restroom in place & hooked up to utilities.
- BHH'S Building C: Finished first round of concrete walls. Set up for pilaster ours and blockwork while site crews handled soil and environmental tasks, clearing the way for heavier CMU, excavation and structural work anticipated in October.
- South Site-Athletic Fields & Parking Lot: Preparing for Design-Build entity bid process.

FONDER-SALARI TEAM ACTIVITES OF THE MONTH

During the month of September, the Fonder-Salari, Inc. (FSI) team gave a presentation for the Board, detailing the work accomplished under the Bond program and discussing the projects still underway.

FSI reviewed pay applications with new contractors, ensuring that adequate detail is given for all use of contingency funds.

FSI negotiated with the contractor to ensure that no additional funds were used for the Security Camera contract, beyond the contingency that was already built into the contract total.



- Future projects timeline: FSI Team is exploring options to optimize the priority, start, phasing, and duration for future projects, to minimize the impact of the cost escalations.
- Reconfiguration and Value Engineering of Future Projects: Design and approval duration may cause additional duration, potential escalation for overall program.

- Identify most time and budget-efficient means of demolishing existing Konheim building.




