    - ix. Leila - I heard that he was doing one ASB and one Link Crew class.
    - x. Drew - Before covid, we had much bigger attendance. Maybe due to the success of homecoming, we may have smaller attendance for winter formal which may be too soon.
    - xi. Amy - Sadie Hawkins dance style of winter formal?
    - xii. Drew - Maybe invite Ms. Stingray, president of Alumni Association to share our ideas with her?
