



BHHS PTSA General Meeting Minutes August 22nd, 2025

In Attendance - Please see attached sign in sheets. Quorum was met.

Welcome - The meeting was called to order by PTSA President Jenn Pedersen at 9:11am.

Pledge of Allegiance - Board of Education President Rachelle Marcus led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Approval of the Minutes - Jill Egerman presented the minutes from the May 23rd General meeting for approval. HaRim Lee moved to approve the minutes and Hilla Carrel seconded the motion. Minutes approved as presented.

Financial Report - Farrah Dodes presented the financial reports and check ratifications for May and June. For May, the starting balance was \$206,313.14, the ending balance was \$215,074.30 Gaby Alexander made a motion to ratify the checks written numbered 3482-3494 in the amount of \$6,084.91. Clio Biboul seconded. Motion passes. For June the starting balance was \$215,074.30 the ending balance was \$200,272.75. Gaby Alexander made a motion to ratify the checks written numbered 2996-3000 in the amount of \$27,063.53. Dorit Abramov seconds. Motion passes.

National Dues Increase - Jenn Pedersen moved to increase the PTSA dues by \$1 in line with the \$1 national PTA dues increase. Clio Bitboul seconded the motion. Motion passes.

Appointment of PTSA Executive Board Positions- Jenn Pedersen shared that she had formally appointed the following positions at the August 8 Exec Board meeting: VP of Volunteers - Evelyn Lahiji, Ambassador Chair - Liz Nejad, and Reflections Chair - Michelle Yarsharpour. Jenn Pedersen moved to approve the appointments. Hilla Carrel seconds. Motion passes.

Jenn Pedersen then shared that the Parent Social Committee was formed and ratified at the August 8 Exec Board meeting. The members are Farnaz Barkhordar, Clio Bitboul, Yael Hiller, Shirin Lavi, Nathan Kruger, and Jenn Pedersen. Jenn Pedersen moved to confirm this committee. Clio Bitboul seconded. Motion passes.

Appointment of Delegates for PTA Council - Jenn moved to approve the following appointments of the BHHS PTSA Delegates for PTA Council: Tina Richner, and Gaby Alexander, with HaRim Lee and Nathan Kruger as alternates. Sophia Rumanes seconded. Motion passes.

President's Report - Jenn Pedersen discussed past events of the month including textbook distribution, orientation, and the welcome back lunch for staff. Upcoming events include BH Reads at El Rodeo on Aug 24 and author events at BHHS on Aug 25. The all parent social will be Tacos and Tequilla on Sept 10 at the Beverly Cannon Gardens. Coffee with the Counselors will be starting again this year. The first Master Class will be Culinary on Sept 29. Stacey Book discussed our community event of Not Today Cancer's Run of the Stars 5K which will be held on Oct 19 to benefit research for pediatric cancer. Nathan Kruger announced the launch of the annual campaign.

Student Representative Report - Janice Moon and Zev Silver discussed the club info session for how to start a club, and the upcoming club rush. This week is the first WOW week, which is a school spirit week.

Teacher Representative Report - [Sue Yovetich](#) thanked the PTSA and community on behalf of the staff. She will be launching ways to share information, starting with a give/get google form for staff. A give/get google form will be created for parents as ongoing input. Attendance and tardies will be a big focus for this year, which will be tied to incentives and privileges. Teachers will be taking part in Lunch Connections where they will be out interacting with the students at lunch. AVID is a great and growing program.

Principal's Report - Principal Loan Sriruksa discussed Back to School night which will be on Sept 2 at 5:00pm. The performing arts spaces will be opening soon. Counselors are now divided into grades 9/10 and then 11/12 with a more college focus. There is a new policy for tardies. The school is aware of the check in lines. Parents discussed concerns about new devices for 9th graders, the drop off/pick up traffic situation and the after school crazy driving.

Superintendent's Report - It has been a calm start to BHHS. The Peters Auditorium grand opening will be in September. The softball field, tennis courts and the new Konheim are all open or on track to open soon. At BVMS the regulation sized field is underway and there will soon be covered sport courts. There is a big focus at the elementary and middle schools to support the students to get to grade level.
